## GENERAL INFORMATION

### AAC DOG ID CARDS

In order for your dog to compete, your dog must have an AAC ID Card. Please order before the trial and allow 6 weeks to receive it. Once your dog has been measured twice and signed by the judges, it will eliminate the need for measuring when competing in further trials. Forward the application for the dog's card directly to the address on the form including the prescribed fee.

### TRIAL ENTRY FORM

The entry form is to be completed, signed, dated and returned to the Trial Secretary indicated on the form with the appropriate entry fee(s). The fee for each Individual Class is \$15.00 and cheques are to be made payable to **Huckleberry Hounds Dog Sports**. *All registrants are required to assist with the trial and a sign-up sheet will be available on trial day.*

### AAC WAIVER & RELEASE

This must be signed and dated and returned with the Trial Entry Form and fees in order to validate your trial entry.

### Class Descriptions

**Starters Standard Class**-The Starters Class shall be for dogs not having earned the Agility Dog of Canada (ADC) title. Dogs completing the course with three clear rounds, as defined by the Rules and Regulations, shall be awarded the ADC title.

**Gamblers Class** – The handler's strategy is demonstrated and the dog's ability to work at a distance from the handler in this class is shown. The object of this game is to accumulate as many points as possible during the Opening Sequence and successfully finish the Gamble.

**Team Relay**-This game demonstrates team spirit, strategy and sportsmanship. Each team consists of 2 dogs and 2 handlers. Each dog and handler runs one section of the course designed under the guidelines for the Masters Standard class.

**Steeplechase**-This game demonstrates the dogs ability to run and jump at high speeds while maintaining control on the A-Frame and weave poles. This class is open to all dogs eligible to compete in other AAC qualifying events at the Starters, Advanced and Masters level.

**Challenge**-Challenge class is to provide a course that tests the ability of the handler as well as the speed of the dog. Challenge is open to any dogs eligible to compete in the AAC Masters Standard classes. The level of this class is to reflect a similarity to world level courses in its difficulty and handling requirements.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

### **NOTICE TO PARTICIPANTS**

Participants through entry submission, acknowledge they are familiar with the AAC Rules and Regulations, including, but not limited, the following:

- (a) This event is held under AAC Rules and Regulations and is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, purebred or mixed breed, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs showing signs of aggression.
- (b) Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the Rules and Regulations of the AAC and shall conform to AAC specifications.
- (c) No leads, collar, food, toys or any other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, including obstacle familiarization.
- (d) It is understood the entrants alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show grounds. In such cases, no refund of fees will be paid.
- (e) All dogs must be kept in their ex pen, crate or be on leash when not in the ring. All dogs must be in control when leaving the ring after their run. Any dog engaging in aggressive or out-of-control behavior upon exit of the ring will be disqualified and/or be required to leave the show grounds. In such cases, no refund of fees will be paid.
- (f) Entrants must keep crate and exercise areas clean. Please pick up after yourselves and your dog(s).
- (g) There will be no refunds, cancellations or changes after the closing date, except for bitches in season and move ups as per AAC regulations.
